- To qualify for the title of Malaysian Champion a dog must be over 15 months old and win 6 CAC. Those below 15 months are eligible for the Malaysian Junior Champion title by winning 3 JCAC from Puppy & Junior Class. ***SPECIAL EXEMPTION – Overseas Adult Champions from FCI countries, who enter the Champion Class and win 2 CACIBS over this weekend will be eligible for the title of Malaysian Champion.*** Overseas Champions who wish to get the title of Malaysian Champion by winning CAC, must NOT enter the Champion Class, but must enter Intermediate or Open Class where CAC is offered and which is eligible for CACIB.
- MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) & Junior Challenge Certificates (JCAC) will be awarded at ALL shows. CACIB'S will be awarded at the FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOWS, to exhibits entered in the **Intermediate, Open & Champion class ONLY**. Junior & Veteran CACIBS will also be awarded at these shows to dogs entered in the Junior & Veteran Class.
- Winners of Dog & Bitch CACIB, Dog & Bitch winners from the Junior Class in Breed & Dog & Bitch winners from the Veteran Class in Breed at the **77th MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW** will be eligible for the title of **Malaysian Winner 2026, Malaysian Junior Winner 2026 & Malaysian Veteran Winner 2026**.
- Winners of the BEST MALE & BEST FEMALE at the **33rd & 34th MKA FCI A2O CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** will be awarded A2O Champion CAC which goes towards their FCI A2O Champion Title.
- Winners of the BEST MALE & BEST FEMALE at the **19th & 20th MKA SOUTH EAST ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** will be awarded SEA Champion CAC which goes towards their SEA Champion Title.

General Information

Quarantine Waiver

The MKA has obtained a **Quarantine Waiver** for overseas dogs from all countries participating in these shows. To qualify under this scheme, all dogs must have valid **Rabies vaccinations** and be up to date with their routine vaccinations.

Import & Export Permits

The MKA will arrange the following for all overseas exhibitors:

- Import Permit
- Quarantine Waiver
- Export Permit
- Health Certificate

For the issuance of the Export Permit and Health Certificate, all dogs must undergo inspection at the Government Veterinary Department according to the following schedule:

- **Thursday, 3 September, 8:30 am** – Dogs attending the Grooming Certification.
- **Thursday, 3 September and Friday, 4 September, 8:30 am** – Dogs attending the Conformation Shows.

[The MKA will arrange and cover the cost of transportation between the official accommodation and the Government Veterinary Department at the designated inspection times only.](#)

Return Flight Recommendations

To avoid any inconvenience caused by delays in the issuance of Export Permits and Health Certificates, we strongly recommend that exhibitors do not book return flights before:

- **After 12:00 pm on Saturday, 5 September 2026** for Grooming dogs.
- **Monday, 7 September or Tuesday, 8 September 2026** for Conformation Show dogs.

Permit & Health Certificate Fees

The fees for Import & Export Permits and Health Certificates are as follows:

Standard Rates

- First dog: **RM900**
- Second and each additional dog (travelling with the same owner/handler): **RM550 per dog**

Hong Kong, Taiwan & Japan

Due to additional documentation requirements, the fees are:

- First dog: **RM1,100**
- Second and each additional dog (travelling with the same owner/handler): **RM550 per dog**

Important Notes

- Dogs must travel under the name of the same owner or handler.
- These fees are subject to change, and any additional charges must be paid at the show.
- All fees are collected during online registration and are **non-refundable**.
- If travelling with multiple dogs, please register all dogs in a single online submission. Once your initial registration has been completed, **no additional dogs may be added or amended**. Any subsequent registration will be treated as a new entry and charged accordingly.

Vaccination Requirements

All dogs entering Malaysia must meet the following vaccination requirements:

- Rabies and routine vaccinations must be administered **at least 31 days before arrival in Malaysia** (except for dogs from Indonesia, where different requirements apply).
- Vaccination certificates must be endorsed by the **Competent Authority (Government Veterinary Department)**. Certificates issued only by a private veterinary clinic will not be accepted.

Microchip Requirements

All dogs entering Malaysia must be implanted with a **readable 15-digit ISO-compliant microchip**.

Microchip numbers will be verified upon arrival at and departure from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA).

Owners using **AVID microchips** must bring their own compatible microchip scanner. AVID microchips without a scanner will **not** be accepted.

Import Clearance

To obtain import clearance, all dogs entering Malaysia must be accompanied by the following original documents:

- Original Export Health Certificate issued by the country of export.
- Original Export Permit issued by the country of export.
- Import Permit for re-entry into the country of origin (where applicable).

Arrival & Departure

All overseas exhibits must enter Malaysia through the designated entry point, **Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)**.

- **Arrival:** No earlier than **Wednesday, 2 September 2026**.
- **Departure:** On or before **Tuesday, 8 September 2026**.

Acceptance of Entries

The MKA will only accept entries from overseas exhibitors who have obtained their **Import Permit** through the MKA.

Online Entries & Payment

Entries for ALL overseas entries **MUST** be made online via our website www.dogsmalaysia.my. Please CREATE an ONLINE account, before attempting to register your entries.

We strongly advise you register your entries in good time, so that we can help you out should there be any problems.

Accommodation

All overseas exhibitors are **required** to stay in accommodation arranged by the MKA, as these properties are registered **Home Quarantine Units** approved by the Quarantine Authorities.

Please note that exhibitors who do not book accommodation from the MKA's approved list **will not be permitted to participate in or enter the shows**.

As the number of approved accommodations is limited, bookings will be accepted on a **first-come, first-served** basis.

Location & Transportation

All approved accommodations are located approximately **35–45 minutes** from the show venue.

Exhibitors are responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from the venue. Transportation services are available at an additional cost—please refer to the **Transportation** section below for details.

Depending on the number of exhibitors staying at each location and the size of their dogs, shared van transportation may be available.

Homestay (Private House)

We have arranged a selection of private homestay accommodations (Airbnb) where exhibitors may stay together with their dogs.

As these are private homes, guests are required to bring their own towels, toiletries, and other personal essentials.

All bedrooms are air-conditioned, and each house is shared by multiple exhibitors. However, each bedroom is private and reserved exclusively for your use, with a maximum occupancy of **two persons per room**.

Dogs are permitted to stay in the bedrooms with their owners.

This version sounds more professional and welcoming while making the accommodation arrangements and expectations clear.

Cost per night **PER ROOM**

Single room – RM350 (Queen size bed - Max 2 people occupancy)
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Refundable Security Deposit of RM350 per room will also be charged at the time of booking. Any damage to room or property will be deducted from Security Deposit. The Landlord will return security deposit to you directly upon checking out.

Transportation

Exhibitors requiring **private van hire, airport transfers, or daily transportation** between the accommodation and the show venue are requested to contact our appointed transport provider directly for a quotation and booking based on your individual requirements.

All overseas participants MUST submit all entries ONLINE at www.dogsmalaysia.my on or before **6pm (GMT+8), 31st July 2026**

Please create an online account before proceeding with Online Entry!!

Before making online entries, please ensure you have the following documents available for acceptance of entry :

1. Vaccination Card of Animal Including Rabies and Regular Vaccinations, complete with Microchip number stated.
2. Passport Information page of the Person Traveling with the Dog
3. Flight Booking information/ Flight Ticket with complete Itinerary of the person traveling with the dog
4. Pedigree Certificate of the Dog, preferably with Microchip number stated.
5. Two colour photographs of the dog in the following poses - dog sitting down facing camera with face clearly visible AND pic of the body of the dog (stacked) to be submitted at time of online entry.
6. Dogs from **INDONESIA must** comply with the entry requirements stated.

If any of the required forms are missing or illegible, we reserve the right to reject the application. We recommend you do your online entries early, so we can contact you if anything is missing or illegible!!
